

**The World of Sheila Graber- Celebrating 50 glorious years!**

The exhibition celebrates over 50 glorious years of Sheila's work, and conveys her wide range of animation and painting in a successful career that stretches from childhood to the present day.

Sheila has always based her work on the environment she lives in. At the age of 11 she painted the nearby Colleys Farm (now the site of the S/T Marine College.) Living on the Lawe top from age of 13 to 25 she painted it's streets and parks as well as catching the river when it bristled with cranes and the busy mill dam coal staithes-which were situated just outside the Customs House.

From 1970 animated films began to replace the medium of paint and Sheila put much of her creative energy into making films on artists to help in her teaching of the history of art. Instead of painting her environment she now made films about it..covering everything from cats to crotchet.

Still continuing to produce movies from 1993 onwards she once more started painting .. her garden,cats and the coastline now with an extra mystical strength which grows from a huge respect and love of the world about her.

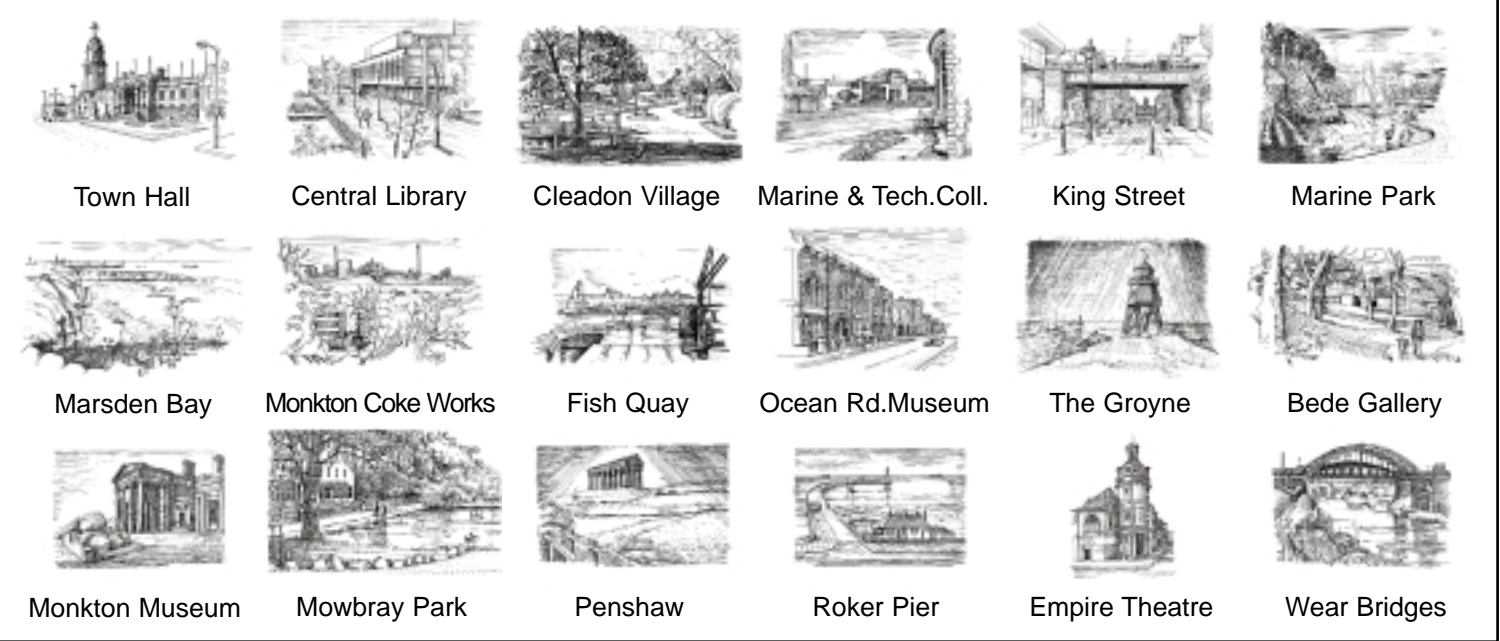
